Form BL-01, *New Business License Application*,
By Drop Box (DRT Main Office Barrigada) and Mail**

Barrigada, Guam – While Guam remains in PCOR1, the Guam Department of Revenue and Taxation is announcing that it is now accepting Form BL-01, *New Business License Application*, by mail and by drop box at the DRT main office in Barrigada.

DRT's Business License Branch will review applications for completion and transmit *completed* applications to the appropriate agencies at the Business License and Permit Center at the DWP Compound in Tamuning for further processing and so that applicants may schedule to obtain the proper inspections and clearances as needed. **The Business License and Permit Center (BLPC) will be operating by appointment only beginning Monday, September 28, 2020.**
