Meeting begins at 5:10pm. President Franklin Leon Guerrero, Secretary Tiffany Tam, member Bing Mejia, and inspector Mike Certeza were in attendance.

Pursuant to 3 GAR, Chapter 2, Alcoholic Beverage Control Board Section 2101. Application. The following information is submitted:

Old Business: *Minutes of Meeting – May 27, 2015 (Approval)
Feb. 25 and April 08, 2015 (Pending Approval)*

February 25, 2015 minutes were still pending approval. Bing Mejia motioned to approve April 8, 2015 minutes as corrected. President Leon Guerrero seconds the motion. None opposed. Motion carries.

New Business:

- 1) Alcoholic Server/Training Program
Members of ABC Board were issued/provided copies on Bill No.9-33(Cor)*

This topic was moved to first on agenda as Ms. Mary Rhodes was present to present her proposal to the board.

Guam Hotel & Restaurant Association (GHRA) President Mary Rhodes was guest at meeting. She proceeds first with her presentation of GHRA's proposal on "Responsible Alcohol Server/Seller" training program. Since the passing Bill No. 9-33(COR), the ABC board has to approve with a memorandum of agreement rather than an RFP to begin training program for Guam's servers and sellers. The ABC board would also only has 60-90 days to adopt and enforce such compliance for all alcohol server and sellers; with exception of those has been trained under TIPS, they will be grandfathered into 3 years until their renewal. Currently there are 10,000 on premise that needs training, and 15,000 off premise that needs training. The law passed now requires approximately 25,000 of these individuals to be trained within one year. Ms. Rhodes had explained that GHRA has been training TIPS to their clients and providing the service to members within the industry since 1990. Therefore, she is presenting the proposal to the board today. President Leon Guerrero has asked if he could

observe GHRA's TIPS training program, and Ms. Rhodes agrees. Each board member was given a copy of the GHRA/TIPS training program to review. An official copy of the training DVD was given by Ms. Rhodes.

Ms. Rhodes exits the meeting. President Leon Guerrero requests that Mr. San Agustin to contact all who came before the board – those who had exhibit interest to be trainers, or solicit request – to present to the board of their proposal so that more than one proposal may be reviewed.
